The Georgia Asian American & Pacific Islander (AAPI) Task Force is partnering with the Center for Pan Asian Community Services (CPACS) to host a very special Reception on Friday, June 21, 2013, honoring Georgia's Asian American Commissions, keynoted by former Georgia Governor Roy Barnes. We will also be recognizing Lani Wong and Dr. Josephine Tan, the Chairs of the first Commissions under the Barnes and Perdue Administrations. We are writing to ask for your sponsorship. CPACS is the largest non-profit AAPI service organization in the Southeast, and is a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) organization. All donations are tax deductible, and any funds raised expenses costs will be earmarked towards 2014 Georgia AAPI Legislative Day. AAPIs from across Georgia will come together at the Georgia Capitol for the Legislative Day. The goals of the day are to: (1) raise the visibility of AAPIs in Georgia; (2) educate AAPI communities about the importance of civic participation, especially at the state level; and (3) dialogue and develop relationships with policymakers, including state senators and representatives. We anticipate drawing over 200 participants from across the state, and will offer advocacy training, opportunity to meet with legislators, group photo opportunity with elected officials, and a luncheon with government speakers for those who attend.

Data from the recent 2010 Census show dramatic growth of the AAPI population in many parts of the Southeast region and notably in Georgia. Between 2000 – 2010 Georgia's AAPI population grew by over 83%. Georgia is now the home of over 386,000 AAPIs. Our state has the 5th highest growth rate of AAPIs in the nation.
